



## Year 10/11 Subject Selection Process 2016 – Important Dates

Dear Parent/Guardian,

At the commencement of term 3, all year 10 students will be choosing their subjects for year 11 2017. This letter is designed to give you a general guide to the process which will be carried out over terms 2 and 3 as part of the preparation for subject selection.

All students have attended an incursion explaining the various options available to them at the end of year 12 – “Life after School” – as a general introduction. During the remainder of this term they will spend time in their form periods researching and completing activities designed to give them an insight into the careers which would suit them, and the pathways required to achieve their career goal. The students will have access to the Year 11 Senior School Subject Selection booklet online and presentations by a number of staff providing information about subjects they may like to choose.

**Open Reporting Day will be held on Thursday the 30th June.** You will have the opportunity to make appointments with your child’s teacher to discuss their progress. The Career Expo will be held in the school library between 11am and 3pm. I strongly recommend that you and your child have a chat to the numerous training and industry representatives present. It’s your opportunity to ask specific questions relating to your child and the numerous possibilities available. I will also be available for interviews during this time if you would like assistance with career choices.

**The Year 10 Parent Information Evening will be held on Tuesday the 19th July at 7pm in the Gym** at Duncraig SHS. It is highly recommended that you and your child attend as the “Online Subject Selection Process” will be explained in detail. Interviews with the subject selection staff will be held during weeks 2 and 3 of term 3 for those parents/students who require assistance with the process. **All subject selections must be complete and final documentation given to form teachers by Friday the 12th August.**
