



## Information about the Certificate II in Population Health

The Certificate II in Population Health provides an excellent pathway into a range of health related qualifications. The qualification covers the following:

- General capabilities required to work in the health industry including utilising infection control to protect yourself and others, maintaining a safe and healthy workplace, general administration skills for working in health, working as a member of the health team and skills for communicating confidently with others in a health care setting.
- Collection of health data such as blood pressure, pulse, visual acuity and blood glucose levels related to each of the body systems.
- Identifying factors that put people more at risk of developing diseases – these will include lifestyle factors, family history and environmental factors
- Identifying, developing and implementing strategies to educate people on healthy lifestyle behaviours.
