- ❖ Grab a copy of the Notre Dame 2018 Handbook from outside Ms Baker's or Ms Marcon's office. (The application form is in the back of this book).
- ❖ Attend their Admission Info & Expo Evening (includes Alternate Entry processes) Tuesday 5th September & their Open Day on 20th August (Sunday).
- ❖ All undergraduate applications are due by Friday 29th September.

But I want to go to CQ University...

- ❖ Attend the **Flexi-time session on 31st August** when CQ University are coming out to let you know about what they offer.
- ❖ They will outline their application process – it is similar to Notre Dame in that it is application based.

What if I want to apply to a University in another State?

- ❖ Check out page 13 in your TISC guide.
- ❖ Look at the TISC website for links to all of the websites listed on this page as well.
- ❖ You will need to check on closing dates for the various states as most of them run their own version of TISC and will have differing deadlines.

Who can apply through TISC?

- ❖ Australian & New Zealand citizens.
- ❖ People with approved or granted Australian permanent resident status - NOT those who are still applying.

What do I do if I am not eligible to apply through TISC?

- ❖ Contact the ‘International Centres’ of the respective universities you are interested in attending directly. You will need to apply as an International Student – be aware their application deadlines may differ significantly from the TISC ones!

What will I need to apply online?

- Computer and Printer
- Access to the Internet
- Credit Card or you will need to finalise the application and then make payment to the TISC Office.....**applications are not finalised and accepted until payment has been made!**
- Your instruction letter to School Leavers
- TISC Guide
- To have identified the (up to) 6 courses you want to apply for – you need their Course Codes (in TISC Guide).

DON'T THROW THIS AWAY! YOU WILL NEED IT. APPLYING TO UNIVERSITY VIA TISCOOnline (WEB)

- Logon at www.tisc.edu.au.
- You need a User ID and Password.
- Your User ID is your **2017 School Curriculum and Standards Authority Student Number**.
- Access TISCOOnline using your default **Password**.
- Require assistance, email help@tisc.edu.au (and, no, you won't be the only one!).
- Check out the *2018 TISC Guide* for a step-by-step guide.
- You can change your **preferences** online (at no cost).
- You can access your **results** and **offers** online.
- **Application fees** are \$33 for 2015 WA Year 12 school leaver age students
- **Please check that your personal details on the letter are correct.**

All the very best for your studies this year!

How do I choose my 6 preferences?

- ❖ Check out pages 3-4 of the TISC Guide.
- ❖ Do your due diligence before hand – have you gone to the Uni Open Days, spoken with the ‘Prospective Student’ Advisors at the University you are wanting to attend to get advice, looked through the Uni Handbooks etc?
- ❖ Investigate ‘back-up options’ for your preferred courses (e.g. VET Science at Murdoch – Animal Science for the first year and then possible course switch.)
- ❖ Ensure your last preference is a ‘reserve’ in case something goes wrong.....e.g. consider a Prep Course.

Alternate Pathways through TISC...

- ❖ If you are wanting to attend Uni in 2018 via one of these pathways be aware you will apply using TISOnline - but not for ECU (or Notre Dame).
- ❖ If you wish to apply for UniPrep or a Portfolio Pathway to ECU you need to apply direct to ECU via;

- ❖ Attend the Flexi-time session next week (**Thurs 10th August**) where the Uni's with Alternate pathways will all be here to discuss their options with you. **This is a compulsory session for anyone studying 1, 2 or 3 ATAR subjects and any Year 12 with a Semester 1 predicted ATAR of 75 or less.**

- ❖ A UAAL is produced for all students with at least one 2017 WACE course scaled score.
- ❖ Your UAAL (and WACE results) will be available online from Tuesday 19th December
- ❖ A hard copy of your UAAL on official stationery can be ordered online.

Tuesday, 17 Oct

11.00pm - Deadline to add preferences for consideration by Curtin, ECU and UWA for Engineering early offers.

Thursday, 30 Nov

All courses (except the Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery, and the Nursing (BSc) Conversion Program for Registered Nurses (Australian Registration stream at Curtin), and Direct Pathway Medicine and Dentistry at UWA) remain open.
