

Hands on Nursing Experience at ECU

The School of Nursing and Midwifery would like to announce the dates for the 2016 HoT (Hands on Training) Program for Promoting Nursing as a Career to Year 10 Students. The aim of this program is to recruit students who are interested in nursing as a career, to participate in one of our four day placements at Edith Cowan University (Joondalup Campus) on **Tuesday 7 July to Friday 10 July or Tuesday 27 September to Friday 30 September (8.30am – 3pm)**

There is a maximum of 40 places per course and students are selected on a **first come first served** basis providing all the information is complete. Please note that only five applications per school per program will be accepted. There is no cost involved – morning tea and lunch will be provided.

During this program, students will learn from a variety of undergraduate and postgraduate lecturers in a supportive environment, providing them with access to a number of different nursing experiences and areas of expertise. Practical workshops will provide students with the opportunity to learn about a number of principles important to nursing:

- Hand Hygiene
- Recording temperatures, blood pressure and pulse
- Manual handling
- Dressing wounds
- Dealing with “real life” situations (using mannequins)

Students are required to return a letter of recommendation from their school , a resume and the application form - anything incomplete will mean their application will be held up and they might miss out. This is a fabulous program which many Duncraig students have participated in over the past years. Please bring completed documentation to Ms Marcon as soon as it is ready.
