



Long term student accommodation 2016

Muresk Institute offers accommodation for students studying with training providers on campus. Accommodation generally consists of single study bedrooms and shared facilities (bathrooms and lounge/common rooms). All bedrooms are furnished with a bed, wardrobe, desk, chair, desk lamp and bookshelves.

Halls of residence

Southern Hall

The Southern Hall is divided into four small units, ranging from five to eight single rooms with shared facilities. Each unit contains a:

- fully equipped kitchen (including stove and fridge);
- television; and
- DVD player.

Two double bedrooms are available.

Dempster Hall and Hughes Hall

Each hall is divided into four units of 10 or 12 single rooms with a shared bathroom and lounge/common room.

Settlement cottages

Four small cottages collectively referred to as the Settlement. The fully furnished cottages have four, five or six single bedrooms and one double room, a shared bathroom and toilet, kitchen and common lounge. One of the cottages can accommodate people with disability.

Houses

Fully furnished two, three and four bedroom houses inclusive of a shared bathroom and toilet, kitchen and common lounge.

Special access requirements

The Institute can accommodate students requiring special access requirements.

Meals

The Pavilion provides meals and dining facilities. Students have the option to take away their meals.

Recreation facilities:

- recreation room with pool table and table tennis tables;
- floodlit swimming pool;
- floodlit basketball and tennis courts;
- indoor squash court;
- volleyball court;
- fully equipped gymnasium;
- floodlit oval;
- cricket pitch;
- BBQ areas; and
- television and video rooms.

Laundry facilities

Laundry facilities (commercial washing machines and dryers) are available at a small fee for residents' use.



What to bring:

- linen (sheets, blanket/duona) and pillows (mattress protectors are supplied); and
- personal items.

Personal electrical appliances

In accordance with occupational health and safety regulations, any personal electrical appliances/equipment brought to the Institute must be tagged by an electrician. This service can be arranged onsite, at a cost.

Security

Muresk Institute has a Security Officer available to attend to emergencies after hours.

You will be provided with a copy of the Muresk Institute *Community Guidelines* which will give you information about living and studying on site.
