- Training delivered by accredited trade lecturers.
- All Training will be delivered at: 92 Mallard Way Cannington WA 6107.
- Upon successful completion students will receive a Certificate II in building and construction and a statement of attainment towards a Certificate III qualification.
- All students must bring their own steel-capped work boots for both workshop training and on-site work experience.



Duration: 12 weeks (Includes work experience with an employer actively looking for an apprentice).

Enrolment Requirements: Students who are in year 11 and 12 must have a Notice of Arrangements. All students over 18 must be active job seekers. Students turning 16 in 2016 who are disengaged from school are encouraged to apply with S24 forms.

Cost: Students born after 1 July 1998 between 16-17 - course cost is \$415.
Concession cost - \$704.22
Non concession cost – \$1408.44

25% fee deposit required upon enrolment before commencement. Student aged students \$103.75,
Concession \$176.10, Non concession cost \$352.11.

All fees and charges are in line with the Department of Training and Workforce Development (DTWD) VET Fees and Charges Policy 2016. A Future Skills WA program co-funded by the DTWD.

All students who successfully complete are encouraged to apply for a Scholarship through the Construction Training Fund valued at \$250.

The following students are entitled to the concession rate on course fees:

- a) Persons and dependants of persons holding:
 - i) A Pensioner Concession Card.
 - ii) A Repatriation Health Benefits Card issued by the Department of Veterans' Affairs.
 - iii) A Health Care Card.
- b) Persons and dependants of persons in receipt of AUSTUDY or ABSTUDY.
- c) Persons and dependants of persons in receipt of the Youth Allowance.
- d) Persons and dependants of persons who are inmates of a custodial institution.
- e) Secondary school aged persons, not enrolled at school.

If the concession is valid for the full enrolment period, then all eligible units commenced within that period attract the concession rate. If the concession is valid for part of the enrolment period, then only eligible units commenced on or after the start date and prior to the expiry of the concession attract the concession rate.
