



ATAR Year 11 & 12 English Revision System

Students will be allocated:

- **12 Assessments** (4x Comprehending, 4x Responding, 4x Composing)
- **4 exams** consisting of all 3 sections.

COMPREHENDING

Section 1 will consist of 3 questions and have related texts attached.

- Students will receive a minimum of 1 written and 1 visual text with the third question either being a second written or visual text or a comparative question
- A sample answer for each question will be provided (200-300 words, 80-85% level)
- A full question-specific, numerical marking key is provided (based on the SCSA sample marking guide)
- Total mark allocation = 60, with each question worth 20 marks

RESPONDING

Section 2 will consist of 6 questions in the exam (with 3 questions in the assessment format).

Students to complete 1 from 6 (1 from 3 in assess)

- A sample answer for each question representing approx the first third to half of an expected response
- A full question specific, numerical marking key is provided (based on the SCSA sample marking guide)
- Total mark allocation = 25 with each component of the marking key worth 0-5 marks (5 components). An 'Assessment' will be worth 20, with each 5 components worth 0-4 marks

COMPOSING

Section 3 will consist of 4 questions, Students to complete 1 from 4.

- Generally there is more than one way to approach a response, therefore, we have provided 2 sample answers for each question, representing approx the first third to half of an expected response
- A full question specific, numerical marking key is provided (based on the SCSA sample marking guide)
- Total mark allocation = 25 with each 5 components of the marking key worth 0-5 marks. An 'Assessment' will be worth 20, with each 5 components worth 0-4 marks
